Rainbows are a sign & a promise that the storm is past & the sun is coming back.	Pass out animals from the ark to younger pupils as they come in. Tell the story of 'A Special Promise' – lion Storyteller Bible p14. Animals to be placed in to the ark at the correct time.	Develop theme by discussing the rainbow as a sign of hope that the world & it's people had a new beginning. Discuss Desmond Tutu. Values for Life Pg. 213/214
