Information	Prayer Space & entrance hall to have questions & quotes related to the value. Put the name of your friend inside & pray for them.	<u>Courage Stones</u> Take a stone & think about the things you need to have courage for. Pop it in the bowl of water so God can take the trouble away & give you the courage you need.	<u>Candle Prayers</u> Write/draw what you are thankful on the candle cut-outs. A candles light is always the same size no matter what the size the candle is-thank God for caring about everyone no matter what their size.	<u>Peace Doves</u> Write/draw on a dove what is worrying you. Pin it to the board. It will fly the worry to God & give you peace.	<u>Reflective prayer</u> Look in the mirrors & think about what God loves about you. How could you mirror God's love?

Write the name of someone in the class & pray for them.	<u>Through the Storm</u> Think about the things you are finding difficult. Write it on the stormy sea & ask God to give you the courage to face them.	<u>Wrapped Present</u> Have a large wrapped gift on the table with the label 'Love from God'. Thank God for what he has given us.	<u>Peace Objects</u> On the table put a collection of objects that the children associate with peace.	<u>Pipe-cleaner Creations</u> Write words about who God is. Use a pipe cleaner to make something that shows who God is.

What would God say? Put your cut-out on the board.	<u>Screwed Up Paper</u> Write something you have done that is not right. Screw up the paper & put it in the forgiveness bin. God has taken these away and forgiven you.	<u>Truth Belt</u> Make a truth belt with ribbon, 5 cards with the letters spelling truth & the verse 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.' John 14, v6.

Words related to hope and what the ch. think hope is are placed on it with purple ribbon/paper.	<u>Kindness Jar</u> Write something kind that someone has done for you or that you have done for someone else.	<u>Scales & Fairtrade</u> Set of scales to represent justice, various fairtrade boxes/pictures of fairtrade goods. Speech bubbles with sayings that have fair/justice in them.	<u>Boxing Gloves</u> See attached description of what this is.	<u>Jenga</u> Have Jenga bricks on the table, some built and some taken out. Use this to show that if we ask for God's help he will help us to forgive & take some of the hurt away.	<u>Truth Mouth</u> Large mouth made from paper and a box. Do you always tell the truth?
