Put the name of your friend inside &amp; pray for them.</p>	<p><b><u>Courage Stones</u></b> Take a stone &amp; think about the things you need to have courage for. Pop it in the bowl of water so God can take the trouble away &amp; give you the courage you need.</p>	<p><b><u>Candle Prayers</u></b> Write/draw what you are thankful on the candle cut-outs.  A candles light is always the same size no matter what the size the candle is-thank God for caring about everyone no matter what their size.</p>	<p><b><u>Peace Doves</u></b> Write/draw on a dove what is worrying you. Pin it to the board. It will fly the worry to God &amp; give you peace.</p>	<p><b><u>Reflective prayer</u></b> Look in the mirrors &amp; think about what God loves about you.  How could you mirror God's love?</p>

Speech bubbles with sayings that have fair/justice in them.</p>	<p><b><u>Boxing Gloves</u></b> See attached description of what this is.  First assembly of the half term to introduce.</p>	<p><b><u>Jenga</u></b> Have Jenga bricks on the table, some built and some taken out. Use this to show that if we ask for God's help he will help us to forgive &amp; take some of the hurt away.</p>	<p><b><u>Truth Mouth</u></b> Large mouth made from paper and a box. Do you always tell the truth? Use paper to put in truths or say sorry if you have not been truthful.</p>

Purple is the colour of hope.</p>	<p><b><u>Salt Crystals!</u></b> Put salt in to the bottom of a jar &amp; mix with water. Hang a piece of string in to it from a pen. Leave for a few days until the string is crystalised. *</p>	<p><b><u>Scale Prayers</u></b> Use the balance scales to put in a prayer about being fair to other people.</p>	<p><b><u>People</u></b> Take a cut-out person &amp; write if you are a proud dude/dudette or a humble dude/dudette. What would God say? Put your cut-out on the board.</p>	<p><b><u>Screwed Up Paper</u></b> Write something you have done that is not right. Screw up the paper &amp; put it in the forgiveness bin. God has taken these away and forgiven you.</p>	<p><b><u>Truth Belt</u></b> Make a truth belt with ribbon, 5 cards with the letters spelling truth &amp; the verse 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.' John 14, v6.</p>
