


# Cheetahs 'Home Learning' Spring 1 - 2017

## Famous Landmarks

Make a model of a famous UK or European landmark.

*\*You could experiment with different growth conditions to observe the affects e.g no exposure to light*

- Can you draw a picture of each one?

To write a biography you should:

Find out the basic facts of the person's life; think about what else you would like to know about the person, and what parts of the life you want to write most about. Some questions you might want to think about include:

What makes this person special or interesting? What kind of effect did he or she have on the world? other people?

What are the adjectives you would most use to describe the person? What examples from their life show those qualities? What
