


Welcome to Green Class!

Welcome to the Summer term! It's going to be a busy one so lets get cracking!

Curriculum

Our topic this term is 'Hot, Hot, Hot' in which we will be thinking about dragons, the Great Fire of London and hot places and habitats around the world. During Healthy Eating week will look at what humans need to survive, the importance of being hygienic and where our food comes from. We will also be looking at plants, what they need to grow and how important they are to humans.



Maths

As well as continuing to embed our knowledge of number, place value and calculations, this term the children will be focusing on measure, including length, weight, mass and time. We will also begin to use our knowledge of multiplication to recite the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

English

We will be following the Talk for Writing model at the beginning of the term; learning, retelling and re-inventing the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. We will also be using the story to write news reports and explanation texts. Later in the term

we will be looking at a 'Meerkat Mail' and 'Tell me a dragon' (to get our creative juices flowing!)

In RE we will be investigating the questions 'What do Jewish people learn from the story of Moses?' And 'What does it mean to be Jewish?' Whilst studying the story of Moses, the children will be thinking about some of his actions and whether they were right or wrong.



Routines

Everyday at school, your child has a phonics session, a literacy and maths lesson, guided reading activities and attends assembly in the hall.

PE lessons have changed and will now be on Thursdays and Fridays. Thursdays lesson will be taught by Mr Allen from premier sports and Fridays lesson will follow our new 'Real PE' scheme of work and will be taught by Miss Ashley. Please ensure that full PE kits are in school on these days, especially as PE will be held outside when the weather is nice. Long hair also needs to be tied back and earrings need to either be removed or covered up.

Trainers are also required if children wish to use the trim and trail equipment at playtimes.

We aim to hear the children read individually at least three times a week, so it is important that children bring their reading books and reading record books to school everyday.
