<p>1&4&5</p>	<p>Pupils across the school have been observed actively engaging in a wide range of physical activity, this includes complete sport. Pupil voice highlighted that pupils enjoy this opportunity and look forward to it as part of their day.</p>
<p>1&4</p>	<p>All pupils have accessed regular Forest School sessions throughout the year.</p>
<p>1&3&4</p>	<p>Wider access to devices has allowed staff to integrate them effectively into PE sessions. Staff and pupils have been able to self evaluate their work in PE.</p>
<p>1&4</p>	<p>Aim for more pupils to meet the expected swimming standard as set out in the National Curriculum, by the end of KS2. Data for this year shows 11% of the year 2 cohort have already met the 25 metre standard.</p>
<p>1&2&4&5</p>	<p>New resources promote status of physical activity and ensure pupil engagement is high. All resources are of good quality supporting staff confidence in delivering sessions.</p>
<p>1&4</p>	<p>Pupils are able to safely access a large open natural space supporting their physical and mental health development.</p>

<p>1&4&5</p>	<p>Pupils are able to lead their own active play and access a wide range of resources to support this.</p>

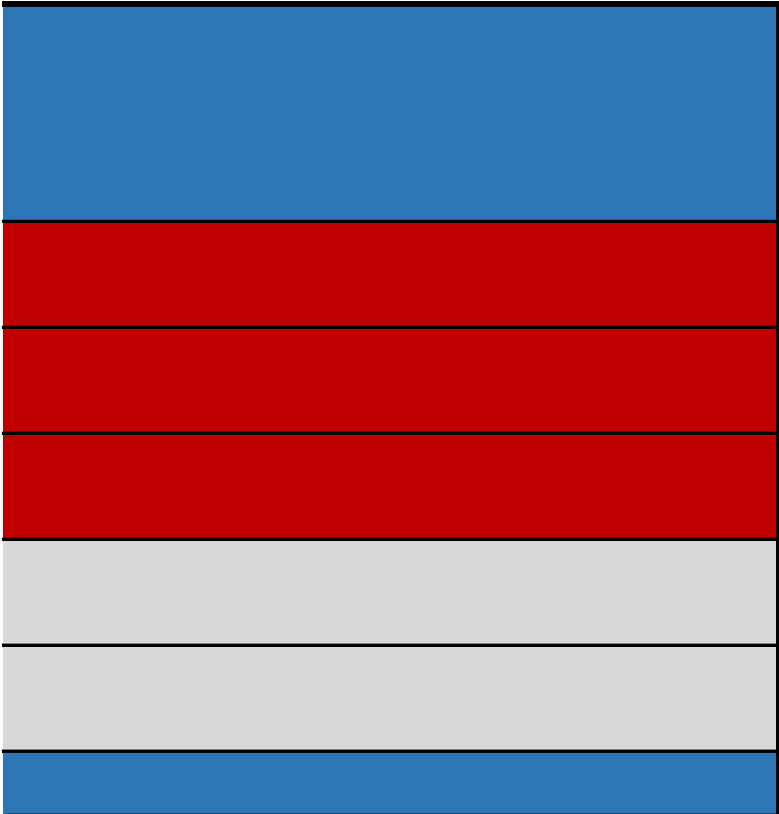
